

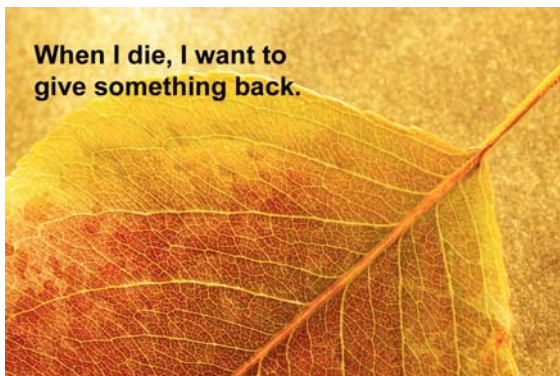
Your questions answered

Is woodland burial affordable? Yes
Woodland burial will usually save money. It will also help protect the environment and make a lasting contribution towards a woodland nature reserve, which will last for generations to come.

Can I have a memorial on the grave? Yes
The Trust has authorised the use of an inscribed oak cross. Other memorials may in future be supplied by the trust.

Can anybody be buried? Yes
We welcome people of all faiths and no faith at all. We just ask that the Trust agrees any form of ceremony beforehand.

Can I have a proper coffin ? Yes
Since we are seeking to develop a beautiful natural woodland, we ask that certain practices are observed which will help the environment. These include such things as trying to make sure that coffins and caskets are made from real wood or other natural products which are bio-degradable.

Why choose woodland burial ?

People who choose woodland burial care about nature and the environment. The creation of natural woodland, where birds, animals and all nature can thrive, is a caring alternative to traditional cemeteries which leave large areas of tombstones. Cremation contributes to global warming by producing greenhouse gases, it is also harmful to the environment with the release of dioxins which create long term pollution. By choosing woodland burial we give something back to our communities and contribute towards the conservation of our environment.

Our woodland is run by a non-profit making charity and is consecrated to come within the jurisdiction of the St Albans Diocese of the Church of England. People choose consecrated woodland burial because it provides the greatest protection in English law. It also provides assurance because everything is protected by the oversight of the church. We can guarantee that you will rest in peace.



St Albans Woodland Burial Trust Charges

Burial

1. Entitlement to single grave space £650

This carries full entitlement to a reserved grave space. If you wish to have two adjacent plots, the fee is twice the cost of the single space i.e. £1300

2. Reservation of a grave space £325

This carries entitlement to a 50% reduction of the cost of a grave space at the time of burial. The remaining sum due will be 50% of the cost of the grave space at the time of burial, not at the time of reservation.

Please note that these charges relate only to the provision of grave space. They do not include fees for church services, ministers fees, charges levied by undertakers or the cost of preparing the ground.

Cremation

3. Entitlement to single grave space (cremation) of ashes £150

This price includes all preparation

4. Reservation of an ashes space £75

This carries entitlement to a 50% reduction of the cost of an ashes space at the time of burial. The remaining sum due will be 50% of the cost of the ashes space at the time of burial, not at the time of reservation.

Other items

5. Become a Friend of the St Albans Woodland Burial Trust £25

6. Dedication of memorial tree £100
